Beginning at a Stake 1250 Paces from Elisha Angling N.W. Corner from which a Black Oak 8 S.W. bears S 41° N. 104 Paces which Stake is 250 Paces S 60 N. from Silas Parkers S.W. Corner thence S 30 E. 390 6/4 Paces to a Stake in Prarie from which a P.O. 13 S.W. bears S. 44 N. 89 1/2 Paces as also a Post Oak 15 S.W. bears S 40 N. 88 N., (this line all Prarie thence S. 60. N. 1600 Paces (at 874 N. struck Frost Creek 8 Paces wide) and corner on a Stake from which a B. Oak 10 S.W. bears N. 27 1/2 N. 82 Paces also a Muskut 6 S. Diameter bears S 29° E. at 97 1/2 Paces thence N 30 N. 390 6/4 to a Stake from which a post O. 18 S.W. bears N. 2 N. 5 4/5 Paces also an Ash 14 S.W. bears S 30 N. 5 3/5 Paces (at 490 Paces struck Spring Cracked 3460 struck Timber, at 3862 struck Creek 6 Paces wide & Timber to the Corner) thence N. 60 E. 1600 Paces to Beginning containing 6,250,000 Sq. Paces in Surface
