

Surveyed for Doctor Blanco the following Eleven Leagues of land  
 in Austin & Williams' Upper Colony, May 10<sup>th</sup> 1833

Beginning at the N.E. corner  
 of S. J. Austin's Bosque survey  
 a Cotton wood 10 m Diam bearing  
 S 70 1/2 E 11 varas from a Cotton wood  
 6 m Diam and N 64 1/2 W 12.6 varas  
 from a Cotton wood 8 m Diam  
 Thence up the Brazos with its  
 different meanders 13750 varas  
 on a right line with the general



Course of S<sup>o</sup> Brazos to a Cotton wood 10 m Diam bearing S 63 1/4 E 3.6 varas  
 from a Cotton wood 5 m Diam and S 66 E 4.4 varas from a Cotton wood  
 9 m Diam - Thence S 62 W 18990.4 varas to a stake in the Prairie  
 Thence S 28 E 13750 varas to a stake in the Prairie - Thence N 62 E 23590.4  
 varas to the place of Beginning - Land one eighth Farming Com<sup>o</sup> Pasture,  
 Growth Oak, Cotton wood, Ash, Hackberry, Mulberry, Muskato &c
