

Flar** , to me well known, who being by me duly sworn, upon oath says, he is now a bona fide resident of the State of Texas, and as such citizen enlisted in the military service of the Confederate States in the late war between the States of the United States as a soldier, and while in active service was permanently disabled so as to seriously impair his ability to perform bodily labor and earn a living for himself and family, such enlistment and service, and wounds and disabilities received therein, being as follows:

Was hounded in Stew Muyier. Fin the Mouth of Opril 1862 in The Padens I mus a member of the Sibley Brigade fifth Livas Caleatry Commonly by This Green, and was Hounden through both arms, both being broken. The Tholder blade of the right Shoulder almost whereby Torse away and the left arms is broken and is now Stiffends Partially

That all the property owned by affiant is not in value as much as one thousand dollars, and makes application for the land certificate, 1280 acres, given him by the act of April 9, 1881.
