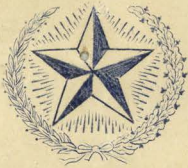
Dear Sir,-

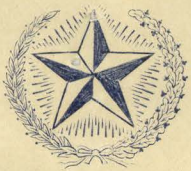

Dear Sir,-

I am sending under separate cover, Corrected Field-notes of 14 surveys in Brazoria County, also returning the three which you recently sent back for correction of errors, the said three sets now being corrected.

Please let me hear from you as to whether these corrected field-notes can be approved in time for the assessor to assess under this corrected acreage for the year of 1914.

In the matter of the W.W. Damon tract or survey, there is no contention that can be made and upheld adverse to his claim and I am of the opinion that Mr. Davis' statements to you if they are as he informs me will readily be seen to be in error to some extent, in rather important instance. He is mistaken in thinking that the Wm. Prater league is short in acreage. Also though the said league is under fence now yet the fence does not come out as far on the ground as the line of the Darss and Burney surveys. And in fact upon the ground as well as in the patent calls there is no other way to make an adjustment of this W.W. Damon survey. He keeps after me to take the matter up with you and I wish to say that I believe the same should be awarded to him without unnecessary delay.
