for Land as a colonist. Do hereby certify  
that we find that he the said Thomas Gray  
Emigrated to this Republic in the year one  
thousand Eight hundred and thirty one, and  
that he is a single man: he is therefore  
entitled to one third of a League of Land  
to be surveyed and located as the law direct-  
eth, Given under our hands this nineteenth  
day of January in the year of our Lord  
one thousand Eight hundred and thirty  
Eight, and of the Independence the second  
year.
