of Daniel I Gilbert upon this Republic for
lands as a colonist. do hereby certify that we
find that Daniel I Gilbert emigrated to the
Country in the year one thousand eight hundred
and thirty five and that he is a single man
he is therefore legally entitled to one third
of a League of Land (which has been legally
transferred to the aforesaid Tho. H. Mays as appears
of Record) to be surveyed and located, as the
Law directs. Given under our hands this the
twentieth day of January in the Year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
eight and of the Independence of Texas the
second Year

Survey no 8 of Eight and one third Acres of Land for
 the H. Mays Assignee of Daniel J. Gilbert situated
 in the County of Bastrop on the East side of
 the Colorado River at the foot of the Mountains
 about forty miles above Bastrop. it being the quantity
 of Land to which he is entitled by virtue of a
 Land certificate no 19. issued by the Board
 of Land Commissioners for the County of
 Bastrop Beginning at the S.W. corner of a
 survey no 4. for G. W. Spier at a stake on the
 bank of the River from which a Bark tree marked
 + Pers. is 75 deg W. 6 rods distant. and a round hole in
 the mountain cleft on the west side of the
 Colorado River sixty feet perpendicular over the
 River bears S 67 deg W. thence is 30. E. with the line
 of G. W. Spier's Survey 27 23. 25. to a stone corner
 from which a post oak marked + Pers S 40. E 10. 25
 distant and a live oak marked + Pers is 38. W 5 rods
