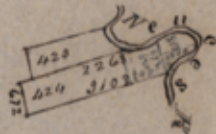

Thence S 40° W 13.53 varas to a stake and mound

Thence S 20° E 6.72 varas to a stake and mound.

Thence N 70° E 21.93 varas to a stake set on the *West* bank
 of the river from which a china tree 6 in dia 7 bears
 N 40° W 6 varas a china 6 S 33° W 4 varas

Thence up the river with its meanders N 43° E 3.94 N 68° W 5.32 S 59° W 4.08 to the place of beginning.
