Hereby ratifying and confirming all and every act that said attorneys

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF TEXAS

To all to whom these presents shall come, know ye

I J. S. Hogg GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW and in accordance with the LAWS of SAID STATE in such case made and provided do by these presents GRANT to the Heirs of David Crockett this heirs or assigns FOREVER, One Hundred and Ninety Six (196) Ac. of LAND, situated and described as follows.

In Bexar County, being Sur. No. 382, in Sec. No. 5, on the waters of Medio Creek, a branch of the Rio Medina, about 13 1/2 miles N. 37 W. from San Antonio. By virtue of Don. Cert. No. 428 issued to said David Crockett, by James S. Gillett, Adjutant General March 13th 1852.

Beginning at the North Cor. of Sur. No. 201 in name of B. D. Bradford for a N.W. Cor. of this Sur. from which a L. O. 4 brs. N. 37 W. 130 rs. Do. 30 brs. N. 33 W. 250 rs.

Thence S 80 1/2 E. 1400 rs. to a stake for N.E. Cor.

Thence South 1204 rs. to a stake on North line of No. 200, in the name of Thos. Davidson for S.E. Cor. Thence West 984 rs. to a stake for N.W. Cor. of No. 200 S.W. Cor. of this Sur. from which a L. O. 8 brs. S. 87 1/2 W. 100 rs. Do. 10 brs. N. 16 E. 150 rs.

Thence N. 43 E. 700 rs. to East Cor. of said Sur. No. 201.

Thence N. 45 W. 1344 rs. to the place of beginning

Bearings Mtd. 7 x 0

Hereby relinquishing to the said Heirs of David Crockett and their heirs or assigns FOREVER all the right and title in and to said LAND, heretofore held and possessed by the said STATE, and I do hereby issue this Letter Patent for the same.
