The School Land Board, at a meeting held in my office August 8, 1956, fixed a price at which your client Daisy Barbee may pay for the excess in Sterling County as follows:

Forms of acceptance are enclosed, which she should sign before some officer authorized to administer an oath. When these acceptances are executed, they should be returned to me together with the sum of \$413.11, which according to my calculation, is the amount due on the excess acreage listed above. Under the present law, we are required to charge a fee for issuing Deeds of Acquittance; in this case, that fee is \$30.00, which may be included in the check for the payment of the land. The check for the above amounts should be made payable to the State Treasurer.
