This is in reply to your favor of the 5th regarding the Mrs Ann Morrison Donation survey 6, Certificate 28/75, patented July 20,1893, and abstracted in Volume 17, State Abstracts as number 7960 in Tom Green county for 140 acres.

The inclosed photostat of tracing made by G W Lane, County Surveyor of Tom Green county when the sprvey was made - April 18,1892 - shows the Mrs Morrison 140 acres and surrounding surveys. The original from which this print was made is in File 2782, Bexar Donation, with fieldnotes for the above survey.

The red ink lines shown on the print is taken from a sketch made by W F Kellis and J J Goodfellow, signed Febry. 9,1918, to show their boundary lines of Coke, Sterling and Tom Green counties. A rough estimate shows about 5 acres to be in Tom Green, and some 3 acres in Coke county. The records do not show the fieldnotes filed here by Mr Goodfellow, as you suggest, increasing the area to 163.6

The correction would be based on the acres contained in the Patent - 140 - giving to Coke county 3 acres; Sterling 132 acres, and Tom Green 5 acres; however, before such change is made the office would like to have the corrected fieldnotes of Mr Goodfellow - of 163.6 acres - giving an estimated area to the three counties as shown by such corrected notes, that a proper distribution may be made in correcting the abstract.

The School Land Board, at a meeting held in my office August 8, 1956, fixed a price at which your elient Daisy Barbee may pay for the excess in Sterling County as follows:

Forms of acceptance are enclosed, which she should sign before some officer authorized to administer an oath. When these acceptances are executed, they should be returned to me together with the sum of \$413.11, which according to my calculation, is the amount due on the excess acreage listed above. Under the present law, we are required to charge a fee for issuing Deeds of Acquittance; in this case, that fee is \$30.00, which may be included in the check for the payment of the land. The check for the above amounts should be made payable to the State Treasurer.

In addition to this sum, it will be necessary to forward a separate check for \$3.04 to defray the expense of recording the Deeds of Acquittance in Sterling County. The check for this latter sum should be made payable to the Commissioner of the General Land Office.
