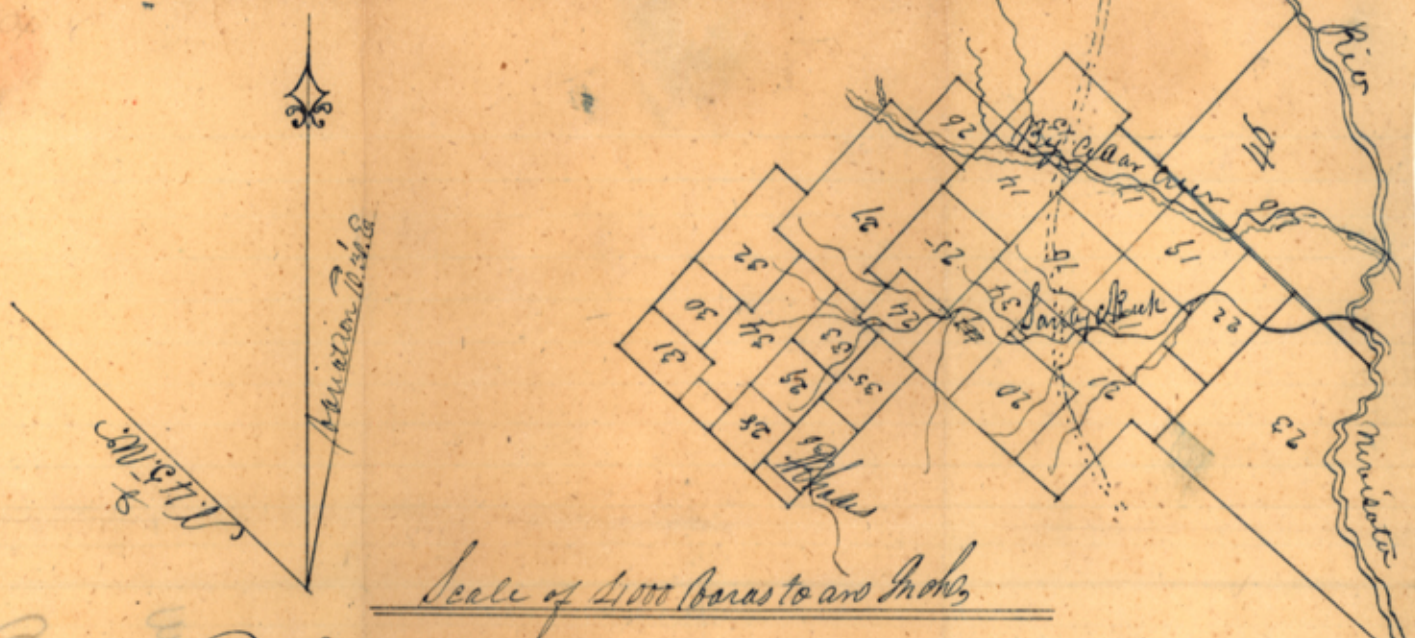

A plot and field notes of a survey of 320 acres of land made for John Rhodes it being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of his headright certificate No 414 Chap 2^d Issued to him by the board of land commissioners for the county of Washington on the 30th day of Decemr 1839 for three hundred and twenty acres.

The said survey is No 36 on the waters of the Missis^{to} on the south side of the Sauantonic Road in the County of Wisconsin.

Beginning at a stake set in the S.E. line of survey No 29 of 320 acres made for Eli Seal and 470 acres from his E line and is the west corner of survey No 35 of 320 acres made for J. A. Phelps and north cor of this survey from which a post oak 20 in in dia bears S 35 1/2 W 7 1/2 bars, and another post oak 18 in in dia bears S 66 1/2 E 2 1/2 bars,

N 45 W. 1805. Thence ^{245 ft} with said survey No 29 at 87 1/2 bars to South cor of 20 survey and East cor of survey No 28 of 320 acres for E Seal the same course with the said N 28 in all 80 bars to cor in place a stake from which a post oak 16 in in dia bears S 81 E 64 bars, and a double post oak 18 & 20 in in dia bears N 84 E 81 bars,
