That *Hardin Howell* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Nine* Months from the *fifteenth* day of *September 1836* until the *third* day of *July 1837* and having been honorably discharged in obedience of the War is entitled to *Two hundred eighty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Hardin Howell* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

A plot and field notes of a survey of 640 acres made for Harwin Nevils, it being a part of the land to which he is entitled by virtue of Bond to warrant no 3162 issued from the war department of the Republic of Texas on the 3rd day of May 1838 for 1280 acres of land,

The said survey is north on the ~~east~~ ^{about 2 miles} side of Big Bear Creek and the ~~Parasote~~ ^{Parasote} on the south side of the same section road in the County of Nebraska, ^{Brazos}

beginning at the South corner of survey No 16 of 640 acres made for Jas Pruitt a stake from which a ^{stick} 11 1/2 in in diameter bears North 8 bars and a ^{stick} 10 in in diameter bears S 74 1/2 bars, 145.5 bars, 1900.

Thence S 45 E at 500 bars Sandy Creek at 1900 bars set a stake for the S corner of this survey from which a ^{stick} 15 in in diameter bears N 45 E 320 bars and another ^{stick} 12 in in diameter bears N 45 W 205 bars,

Thence N 45 E at 1600 bars Sandy Creek at 1900 bars a stake set for the East corner of this survey from which a ^{stick} 10 in in diameter bears N 10 W 28 3/4 bars and a ^{stick} 12 in in diameter bears S 15 W 13 1/2 bars,

Thence N 45 W 1900 bars to a stake set for the E cor of No 16 and S cor of No 7 from which a ^{stick} 12 in in diameter bears S 74 1/2 bars and another ^{stick} 14 in in diameter bears N 45 W 10 3/4 bars,

Thence S 45 W 1900 bars to the place of beginning

Know all men by these presents, that I, Hardin Neville, of the County of Brazos in the Republic aforesaid, have nominated and appointed and do by these presents constitute and appoint Saml^l Armstrong my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name & for my use and benefit, to ask demand and receive, of and from the Government a Patent to twelve hundred eighty acres of land, lying on Cedar Creek in said County, the same having been granted to me for services in the Army of Texas; And I do hereby authorize and empower my said attorney to do and perform any and all acts necessary in and about the premises as fully as I myself could do, and I do hereby ratify and confirm and hold for good and lawful all the lawful acts and doings of my said attorney in the premises.
