A plot and field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for Stephen Cooley it being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of his purchase certificate no 2 3<sup>rd</sup> class, issued by the Board of land commissioners for the county of Robertson on 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1841 for 640 acres of land. The said survey is No. 23 on the waters of the Marsota on the South side of the San Antonio road in the County of Missouri.

Beginning at the East corner of Survey No 19 of 640 acres made for Harshin Mills a stake from which a tick 1/4 in diameter 17 1/2 bars and a post 1 1/2 in diameter 12 bars 180 bars 1/4

S 45 E	1300	Thence S 45 E 1300 to a stake from which a post 1 1/2 in diameter bears N 33 W 6 1/2 bars and another post 1 1/2 in diameter bears S 70 E 9 bars.
S 45 W	2777	Thence S 45 W 2777 bars to corner of Section 4 1/2 in diameter from which a post 1 1/2 in diameter bears N 28 W 1 1/2 bars and another post 1 1/2 in diameter bears S 70 W 8 bars.
N 45 W	1300	Thence N 45 W 1300 bars to a stake in the S.E. boundary line of No 18. 640 surveyed for H. Neils from which a post 1 1/2 in diameter bears N 33 E 1 1/2 bars and another post 1 1/2 in diameter bears S 45 W 17 bars.
N 45 E	2777	Thence N 45 E with said Neils line 2777 bars to the place of Beginning
