This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

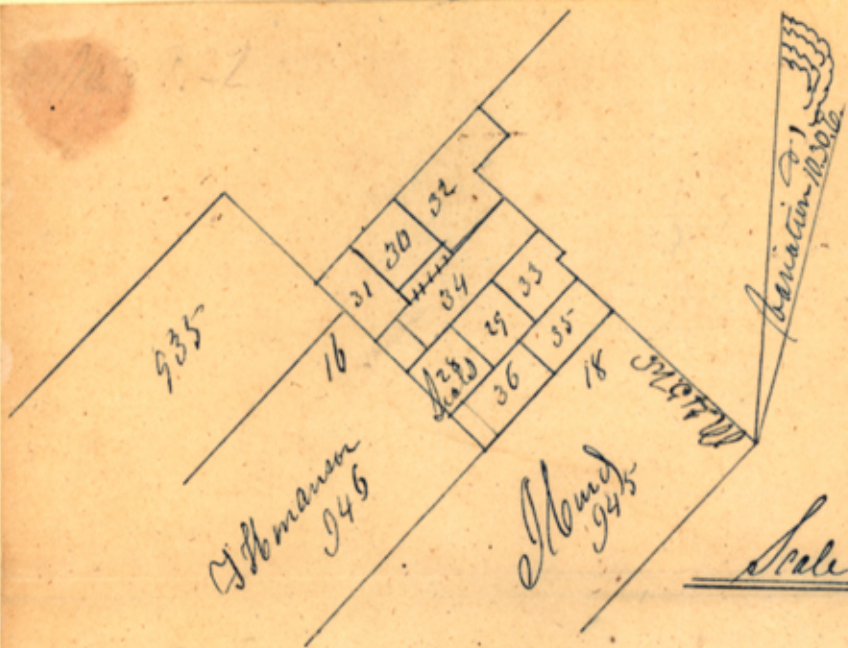

A plot and field notes of a survey of 320 acres of land made for Eli Stals, it being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of County warrant No. 1674 issued from the war department of the republic of Texas on the 9th day of January 1838 for 320 acres.

The said survey is made on the waters of the Navasota ^{in Brazos Co} south ~~of the side of the San Antonio road with the county of Missouri~~ ^{beginning} at a stake set in the N.E. boundary line of old survey ~~N. by E. from the~~ ^{beginning} of the ~~survey~~ ^{of} J. Henderson and 1656 bars from his corner from which stake a ^{1st} Post Oak 10 In in dia bears N 31° 12' W 12 1/2 bars and another ^{2nd} Post Oak 15 In in dia bears N 71° 28' 2 1/2 bars
