A plot and field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for Edward W. Taylor. It being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of his headright certificate in 62 days issued by the board of land commissioners for the county of Washington on the 2^d day of May 1836.

The said survey is 140 on the waters of little Brazos and Thompsons creek on the south side of the San Antonio road, in the County of Tarrant.

Beginning at a stake set in the San Antonio road for the North corner of a survey of 390 acres made for Horace D. Taylor from which stake a 2^d stake 24 1/2 in diameter bears S 74 1/2 E 37 bars, and another stake 20 1/2 in diameter bears S 34 E 31 bars

S. 45 E. 1370. Thence S 45 E. at 100 bars a branch runs westerly into the little Brazos at 1370 bars with the N & line of the said 390 acres survey to the East corner of the said survey in the N. W. line of a league survey in for the heirs of John Williams, and a stake from which a 3^d stake 24 1/2 in diameter bears N 36 1/2 E 140 bars and another 3^d stake 30 1/2 in diameter bears N 41 E 130 bars.

N. 45 E. 1900. Thence N 45 E. with the said line of Williams survey 1900 bars to a stake set in said line for the E. corner of this survey from which a 4th stake 15 1/2 in diameter bears S 32 E 17 bars and another 4th stake 16 1/2 in diameter bears N 34 W 7 1/2 bars.

N. 45 W. 3717. Thence N 45 W 3717 bars to a stake set in the San Antonio road for the North corner of this survey from which a 5th stake 18 1/2 in diameter bears S 28 1/2 E 19 bars, and another 5th stake 30 1/2 in diameter bears S 67 E 31 bars.

South westerly

Thence with the meanders of the San Antonio road to the place of Beginning.
