A plot and field notes of a survey of 320 acres of land, made for James H. Phelps it being the quantity to which he is entitled by virtue of 13th warrant N^o 3004 issued to him from the treasury of the Republic of Texas for 320 acres of land on the 13th day of December 1835. The said survey is on the waters of the Missouri on the south side of the San Antonio Road in the County of Missouri.

Beginning at a stake set in the N.W. line of Survey N^o 24 of 320 acres made for the East Corner of Survey N^o 33 of 320 acres made for W. Middleton from which a post oak 24 in in diameter bears S 80 W 17 1/2 bars, and another 12 in diameter bears N 34 E 5 1/2 bars.
