A plot and field notes of a survey of 640 acres made for Hanson & Cattlett. It binds the quantity to which he is entitled by virtue of his priority to certificate No 529 issued by the board of land commissioners for the county of Brazoria on the 17th day of May 1835. The said survey is N 45 on each creek. The waters of the Nevada in the county of Brazoria.

By running at the W cor of survey No 16 of 640 acres made for James Purvitt a stake from which a Pot hole 15 in in diameter bears N 15 E 7/8 bars and another 10 in in diameter bears S 47 W 6/8 bars.

N 45 W. 2820. Thence N 45 W at 1476 bars from fields & cor of stake from which at 1806 as said creek at 2820, the W cor of this survey and S cor of survey No 24 a stake from which a Pot hole 10 in in diameter bears S 30 E 3/4 bars and another 10 in in diameter bears N 29 W 1/2.

N 45 E. 1250. Thence N 45 E at 408 bars the N cor of Iburg league N 18 same course with cor at 1250 by a stake at said corner for Iburg W cor and S cor of this survey from which a Pot hole 10 in in diameter bears N 11 W E 1/2 and another Pot hole 12 in in diameter bears N 88 E 5/8 bars.

N 45 E. 2820. Thence N 45 E at 1830 bars same creek at 1900 by the N cor of said league ~~corner~~ at 2820 bars the N W. line of No 16. a stake for E cor of this survey from which a Pot hole 10 in in diameter bears S 73 W 7/8 and another Pot hole 12 in in diameter bears S 60 W 1/2.

N 45 W. 1250. Thence N 45 W 1250 bars with ^{line of survey} cor No 16 to the place of beginning.
