man and is entitled to *one hundred acres* of LAND, to be surveyed after the first day of August 1838.

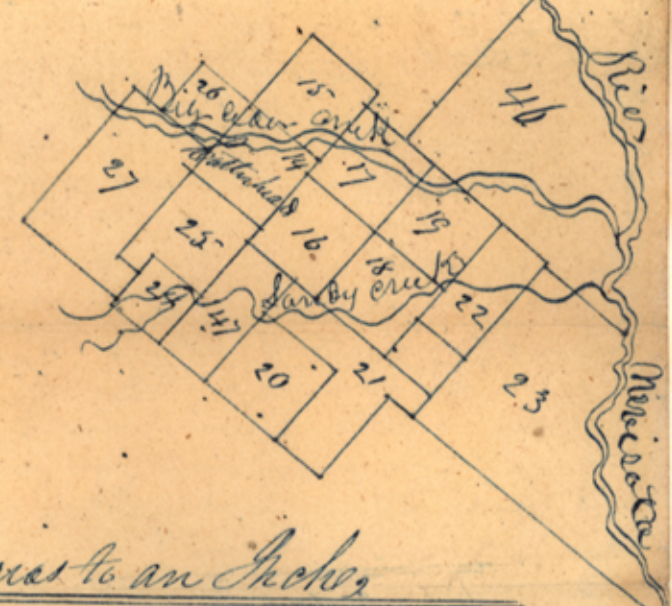

A plot and field notes of a survey of 640 acres of land made for J. H. F. Cathey, head, it being a part of the land to which he is entitled by virtue of his headright Certificate No. 37 class 2^d for 1280 acres of land issued by the board of land commissioners for Robertson County on the 6th day of September 1838 in Brazos County

The said survey is made on the south side of the San Antonio road on Big Cedar Creek in the county of Missouri 4 miles above its mouth beginning at a stake set for the West corner of Survey from which to Post No. 12 in a true bearing N 5 E 19 1/2 and a Black Jack 14 1/2 in in a true bearing N 57 E 16 1/2 being the N. corner of Survey No. 25 in the S. E. boundary of A. T. Lewis's survey No. 27
