That Youngs P. Alstung having served faithfully and honorably for the term of three Months from the first day of March until the twenty eighth day of May 1866 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to three hundred twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Youngs P. Alstung is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

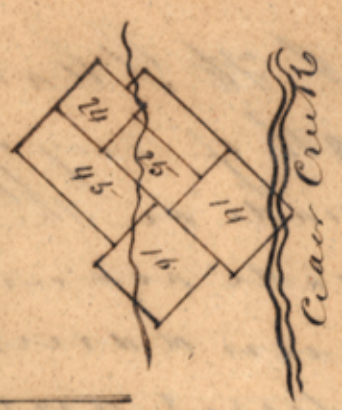

A plot and field notes of a survey of 390 acres of land made for W. G. Butler assignee of J. P. Alsbury, it being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Bounty warrant No 3599. The said survey is No 25 on Sandy Creek waters of the Nevisota, in the County of Brazos,

Beginning at the South Corner of Survey No 14 on the N.W. line of Survey No 16 for the East Corner of this survey a stake from which a Post 15 in in dia bears N 24 W 8 bars and another Post oak 12 in in dia bears S 84 E 14 bars,

S 45 W	1806
N 45 W	1003
N 45 E	1806
S 45 E	1003

Thence S 45 W at 330 bars the West Corner of Survey No 16 at 1200 bars. Crossed Sandy Creek at 1806 bars the East Corner of Survey No 24 a stake from which a Post oak 14 in in dia bears N 13 W 11 bars and another Post oak 16 in in dia bears N 11 E 3 bars,

Thence N 45 W with the N.E. line of said ^{Survey} No 24 at 1003 bars set a stake for the ~~N.W.~~ W. Corner of this survey,

Thence N 45 E at 330 bars crossed Sandy Creek at 1300 bars onto the prairie at 1806 bars set a stake on the S.W. line of Survey No 14 for the ~~N.W.~~ Corner of this survey,

Thence S 45 E with said line 1003 bars to the place of beginning.

Know all men by these Presents:

That I Young T.

Alsberry for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and fifty dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, aliened, released and conveyed, and by these presents do sell, alien, release and convey unto Hanson G. Battie his heirs or assigns a certificate granted to me by the government of the Republic above written for three hundred and twenty acres of bounty land for services rendered in the army of the said Republic, the said certificate is numbered 359 and bears date 26th day of May 1838 — and I declare that I have not hitherto sold, aliened, or mortgaged the above described premises, that they are free from all encumbrances whatsoever, and as such, I will the same to the said Battie together with all and several the privileges and appertinances thereunto belonging for the consideration above written, and from this day forward forever, I dispossess myself of the same, and for myself, my heirs and assigns, relinquish the dominion, title and possession, to the said certificate or the land conveyed thereon, which I have acquired in virtue of the above mentioned title in favour of the said purchaser, and will reconvey and transfer the same to him that he may possess, enjoy and dispose of the same at his pleasure, the same as of any other thing acquired under a just title and legal title for who for him or them, rights or privileges may hold or legally represent. And I bind myself to prove and make good his said title

and to the observance of all the above, I bind
my person and obligate my property present and
future, and submit myself to the jurisdiction
of the tribunals which may be competent to
hold or take cognosance of this business that
they may compel me to perform the same
under all the rigours of the laws, And I
avow and all laws which might favour me
or which would enable me by any means to
set aside the validity of this instrument
contrary to the true intent and meaning they
