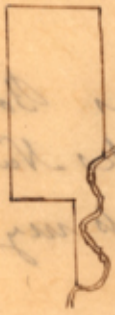

to Joseph Jordan No. $\frac{3121}{8222}$ granted
at the general Land office

Situated in Brazos County at the
Mouth of Carters Creek and on the west Bank of the
Navasoto River and about 10 miles South 56 East
from Boonville Commencing at a stake in the S, E
boundary line of the ^{Augustine} Williams League (it being a third
of a League once surveyed for H Williams and the Certif-
icate lifted and the original field notes returned to
me Commencing at a stake in the S, E Boundary line
of the Williams League) from which a $\frac{3}{4}$ feet in diam
marked L bares S 1 E 11 vars then running S 45 E at 9800
vars Carters or Saline Creek 4050 vars to ^{North} ^{Blawie} ^{Blawie} ^{Blawie}
Corner a stake from which a Double Elm marked L bares
