day of January 1836 and having been honorably discharged by reason of expiration of term of service

is entitled to Three hundred and twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Oli Seals is entitled to hold said Land, Alienate, Convey and Donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.



Bounty Land Certificate for three
Hundred and twenty acres of Land
issued at the adjutant Generals office
on the 2^d day of July A D 1852 n^o 1118.
To have and to hold the same unto
him the Said Joshua Seal his Heirs
and assigns forever I do hereby fully
authorise the Commissioner of the General
Land office so soon as said Land
shall be located to issue a Patent
for the same to Said Joshua Seal
as my assignee
