1859 of the District Court of said county an uncon-  
ditional certificate for Six Hundred and forty acres  
of Land was ordered to issue to Henry A. Adams  
by virtue of conditional Certificate No. 2 issued by  
the board of Land Commissioners of said county  
on the 15<sup>th</sup> of July A.D. 1838 and the proof required  
by law made before said court,

Therefore know ye  
that the said Henry A. Adams is entitled to Six  
Hundred and Forty acres of land by virtue of  
said order of said District Court to be located upon  
any vacant and unappropriated public domain  
of the state of Texas.


