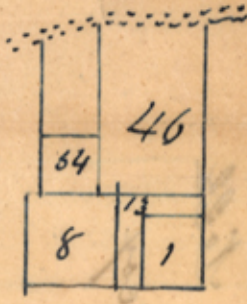

soever to my head-right certificate for a third of a league  
of land issued to me in said County of Brazoria, on  
the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February A.D. 1838 & numbered 277  
and all lands located under & by virtue of the same  
& have & hold the said Certificate & the land located  
or to be located under & by virtue thereof, to him his  
heirs & assigns forever. And I hereby authorize said  
Hall his heirs, representatives or assigns to receive from  
the land office of said Republic a patent to said  
land to be made to him, in full satisfaction of my  
claim for land by virtue of said Certificate  
witnessed my hand & scrawl by way of seal this  
fifteenth day of February A.D. 1842
