Begining at the South cor of survey N 20 of 640 bars made for I. Seal a stake set in the N.E. line of an old survey N 18 made for I. Beard from which a Post oak 16 In in dia bears S 78 W 4 bars and a Blk jack 6 In in dia bears N 74 W 30 bars, this cor is in prairie

N 45 E. 1250. Thence S 45 E with line 1250 bars, to his East cor in the N.W. line of a league survey for J. W. Stewart a stake from which a Post oak 10 In in dia bears N 80 W 6 bars and another Post oak 10 In in dia bears S 12 E 8 bars

N 45 E. 2900. Thence N 45 E with the said line 2900 bars to the North cor of the said survey of one league a stake from which a Post oak 10 In in dia bears South 10 E 5 bars

Law that he arrived in this Country in January The Year
Eighteen Hundred and Thirty Six, that he is a married
man and the Head of a Family, his family are now here
and entitles to Two Thirds of a League and One Labor of Land
as an Augmentation (He having previously obtained a Cer-
tificate for One Third of a League of Land) Upon the Con-
dition of paying at the rate of Five dollars for every
Labor of Arable or Temporal Land and Two ²⁰/₁₀₀ dollars
for every Labor of Pasture Land which may be contained
in the Survey Secured to him by this Certificate —
