Surveyed for C. C. Seal, Assignee of
Thomas Gates three hundred and twenty
acres of land by virtue of a duplicate Do-
nation Land Warrant No. 701 for 640 acres
issued to Thomas Gates on the first day
of June 1855 by James S. Gillett Adjutant
General being bounded and described
as follows viz. lying in Brazos County on
the waters of White's Creek, ^{about 7 1/2 miles N.W. of Bronkville} beginning on the
North East line of Stephen Jones' league South
45° East 500 varas from the South Corner
of a one hundred and forty three acres
survey made for M. A. S. Evans at a
stake from which a Post Oak 12 inches
in diameter bears S. 48 1/2° W. 4 varas and
a Post Oak 12 inches in diameter bears
N 31° E 6 varas, thence running S. 65° E. 923
varas with the league line of the said Ste-
phens Jones' survey to a stake at the
East Corner of the same and in the North
^{West} line of a survey of two labors made for
James Hope from which stake a Post
Oak 15 inches in diameter bears S 88 1/2° E 23
varas and a Post Oak 19 inches in diameter
bears S 8° W 2 1/2 varas, thence N 45° E with
the North West line of the said survey of
two labors made for James Hope 347 varas
to a stake at the North corner of the last named
survey from which stake a Post Oak 11 inches
in diameter bears S 48° E. 8 varas and a
Post Oak 8 inches in diameter bears N 1/2° W
9 varas, thence S 45° E with the North
East line of the said Hope's survey 568

varas to a Post Oak marked A from which
another Post Oak 12 inches in diameter bears
N. 83° W. 9 varas thence N. 45° E. 997 varas to
a stake from which a Post Oak 16 inches
in diameter bears N. 77° E. 14 varas and a Post
Oak 12 inches in diameter bears N. 64° W.
14 varas, thence N. 45° W. 1491 varas to a stake
from which a Pin Oak 6 inches in diameter
bears S. 68° E. 9 varas, and a Post Oak 16 inches
in diameter bears N. 88° W. 11 varas, thence
S. 45° W. 1344 varas to the place of
beginning

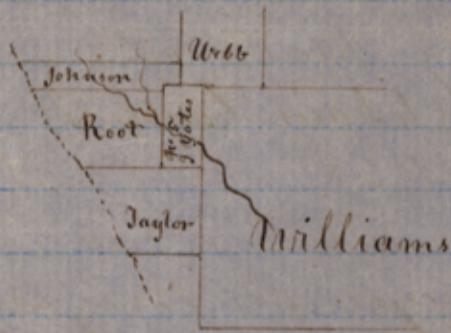

hundred and seventy nine (279)
acres of land made for Thomas
Gates by G. L. Seal assignee
it being a part of the unlocated
balance to which he is entitled

by virtue of a Duplicate Land Warrant for 640 acres
issued to Thomas Gates by James S. Gillett No. 701

bearing date the first day of June 1855 said land
lying in Brazos County on the waters of Thompson's
Creek about eight ^{North 77°} miles West of Boonville

Beginning at a stake at the South corner of a survey
made for J. B. Root from which stake a Post
Oak 12 inches in diameter bears $S. 11^{\circ} W. 15$ varas

and a double Black Jack bears $N 70^{\circ} E 16$ varas
thence running $N 45^{\circ} E$ with Root's South East
line and Samuel Johnson's South East line passing

Root's East corner at 1548 varas and running
1700 varas to a stake at Johnson's corner from
which stake a Black Jack bears $S. 86^{\circ} E. 4$ varas

and a Black Jack bears $S. 22^{\circ} E. 4\frac{1}{2}$ varas, thence
 $S 45^{\circ} E$ ^{with} Johnson's line and Webb's line ^{927 varas} to a stake

at the North corner of John Williams'
Seague from which stake a Post Oak 12

inches in diameter bears $N 28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 11\frac{1}{2}$ varas and
a Post Oak 11 inches in diameter bears $S 44^{\circ} E$

9 varas, thence $S 45^{\circ} W$ with Williams' line
crossing Webb's branch at 1030 varas and run-

ning 1700 varas to a stake at the East corner
of E. W. Taylor's Survey from which stake a

Post Oak 18 inches in diameter bears $S 33^{\circ} E$
 $17\frac{1}{2}$ varas and a Post Oak 12 inches in

diameter bears $N 77^{\circ} E 10'$ varas. thence $N 45^{\circ} W$
with Taylor's line 927 varas to the place of
beginning.
