A plot and field notes of a survey of 9,333,333 bars made for A.A. Millican, Esq. being a part of the land to which he is entitled by virtue of his headright certificate No 65 issued to him on the fifth day of February 1838 by the board of land commissioners for Robertson county, for one league and one labor of land.

The said survey is No 53 on the N. side of the N. side of the county of Brazos.

Beginning at the lower upper corner of Survey No 52 made for A.A. Lancaster, a line 10 ft in airt from which an other line 14 ft in airt bears N 44 E 4 bars, two Hollys bears S 20 E 5 bars and a line 12 ft in airt bears west 9 ft,

N. 45. W. 2000. Thence S 45 W at 2000 bars with a line of No 52 a stake for south cor of this survey from which a Holly bears 10 ft in airt bears N 10 E 4 bars, and an Elm 10 ft in airt bears N 77 E 5 bars.

N. 45. W. 2270. Thence N 45 W at 200 bars to the E cor of James old survey same course with James 2070 bars to the South cor of Langhams survey a stake from which a Holly bears 14 ft in airt bears S 2 W 11 bars, and a post oak 7 ft in airt bears S 71 E 4 bars.

N. 45. E. 3800. Thence N 45 E 3800 bars with Langham to his East cor on the N. side of the N. side of the county of Brazos a stake from which an Elm 10 ft in airt bears N 9 W 4 bars and a water oak 10 ft in airt bears S 43 W 7 bars, Thence down the N. side of the N. side of the county of Brazos to the place of beginning.

The above survey contains five labors of arable land and four and one third labors of pasture land.

Witness my hand and seal this 10th day of June 1842.
