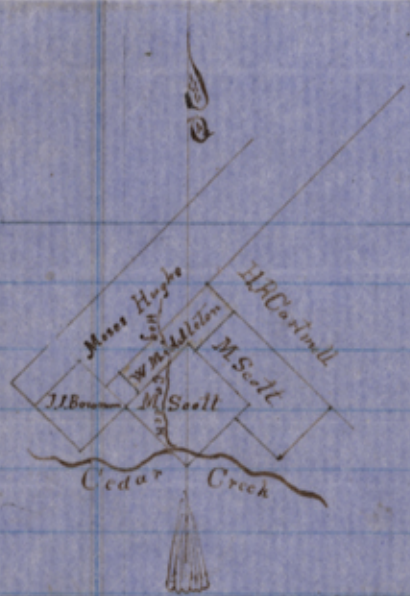

 being the quantity of land to  
 which he is entitled by virtue of certificate  
 No 6 Issued by the board of Land Commis-  
 sioners for Brazos County on the 3<sup>d</sup> day  
 of April A.D. 1843.

Said Survey is in Brazos County on the  
 Waters of Cedar Creek a tributary of the  
 Navasota River about ~~14 1/2~~ <sup>14 3/4</sup> miles ~~N 20° E~~ <sup>N 45° E</sup> from  
 the Town of Bonville Beginning at  
 the original North corner of a Survey made  
 in the name of Moses Scott (No 15 on the Map of  
 said County) from which a P. Q. 10 m in dia. brs  
 S 60° W 3 1/2 m & a P. Q. 10 m in dia. brs N 10° E 6 1/2 m

N 45° E 200 m

Thence run N 45° E with the N.E. boundary of  
 said Scott Survey 200 m and corner a Stake  
 which also serves for the western corner of another  
 Survey in the name of Moses Scott from  
 which Stake a P. Q. 15 m in dia. brs S 48° E 6 m  
 & a P. Q. 14 m in dia. brs S 35° W 20 m

N 45° E 1130 m

Thence run N 45° E 1130 m with the N.W.  
 boundary of said Scott Survey to the North  
 corner of the same a Stake from which a  
 large double P. Q. brs S 45° W 80 m

 on the S.E. boundary of the Moses Haigh Survey

Hughs Survey & corner a Stake from which  
a P. O. 12 M in dir. brs N 57 1/2° W 5 as and a P. O.  
10 M in dir. brs S 73° E 11 as.

Thence run S 45° E 600 as & corner a Stake  
in the P. M. boundary of said Moses Scott Survey  
(in a thin Oak Thicket)

N 45° E 150 1/4

Thence run N 45° E with the Scott line  
150 1/4 to the place of Beginning.  
Surveyed January 31<sup>st</sup> 1861.
