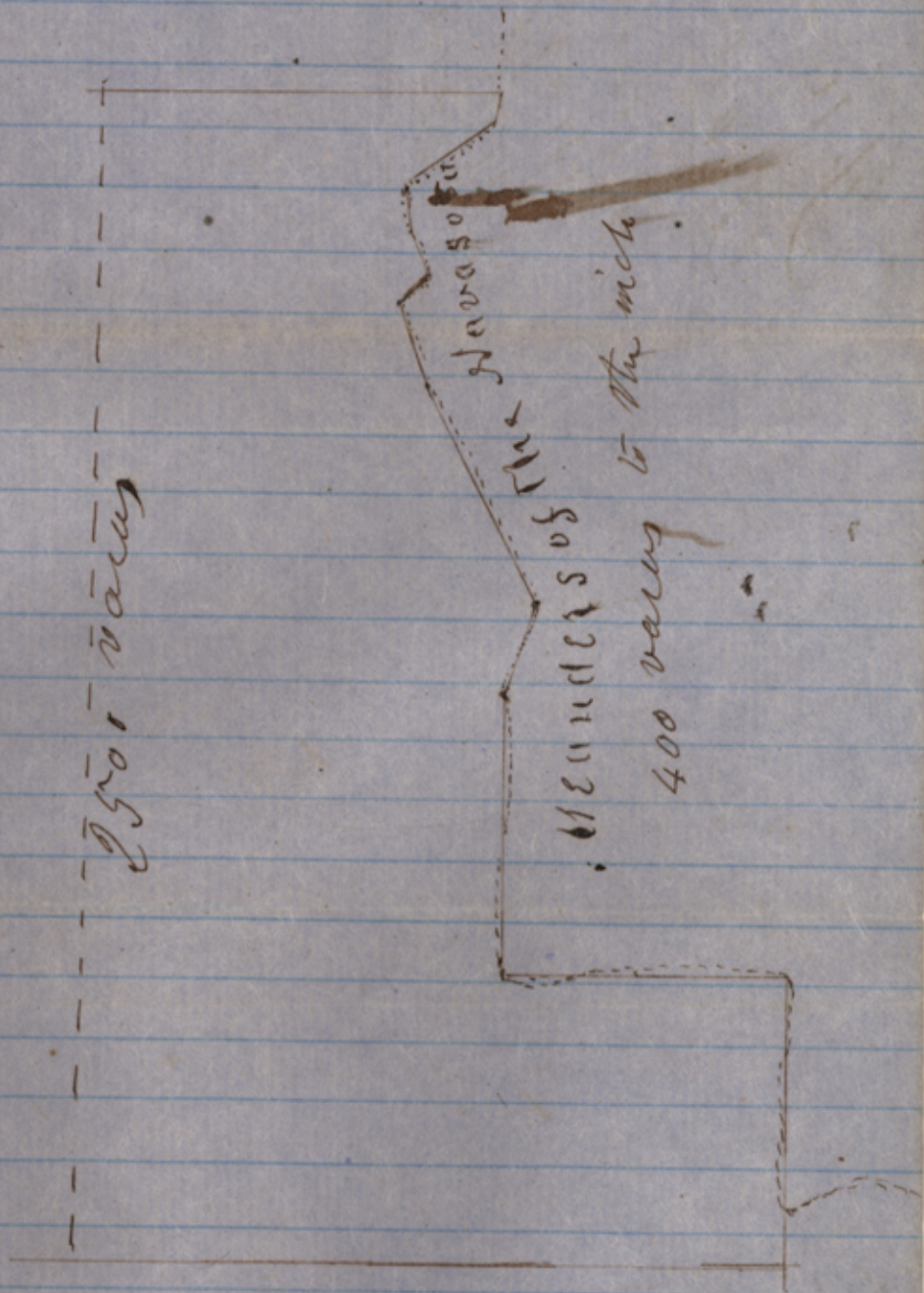
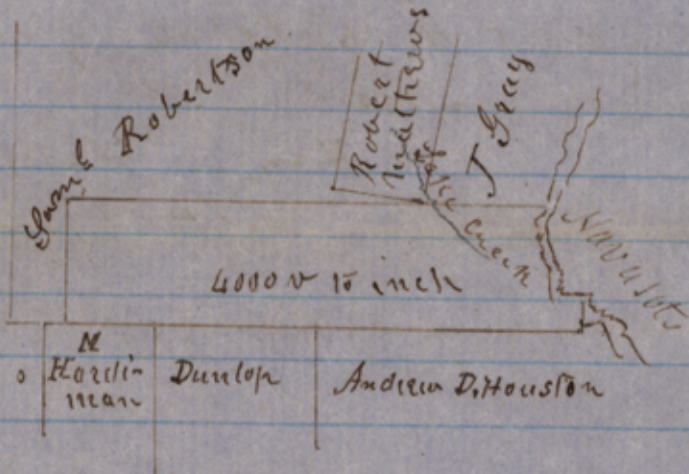

Field Notes of a survey of one League of land made for Sterrett D. Smith, it being a part of the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate No. 3258 / 3359

for one League and one Labor of land, issued February 14th 1854 to Sterrett D. Smith, by J. Crosby, Commissioner of the General Land Office, said land lying in the County of Brazos on the Savasoto River, a tributary of the Brazos River about fourteen and one half miles above the town of Washington and thirteen miles S 47° E from Beauville, beginning on the West bank of the Savasoto River at the lower corner of a survey made for J.
