REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.

ACRES. 415

KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Sam Edwards having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Five months from the first day of October 1864 until the first day of July 1865 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to Nine hundred and fifty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Sam Edwards is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, at Waxton this day of September 1865

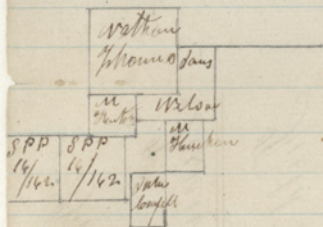

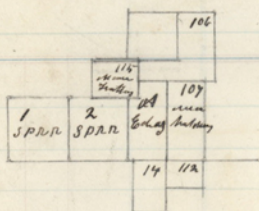
