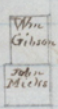

Notes of a corrected survey of 320 acres of Land made for William Gibson it being the quantity of Land to which he is entitled by virtue of the accompanying Affidavit of Settlement made before R. W. Allen Deputy Surveyor of Denton County on the 1st day of June 1856 in accordance with Law

Said Survey is situated in Denton County on the waters of Denton Creek a tributary of the Elm Fork of Trinity River about ~~about~~ ^{twelve} miles about 12 1/2 miles S 13° W from the Town of Denton

Beginning at the North East corner of a 320 acre Survey made in the name of John Mickes (Deer Ears assigned) Thence

West with the North Boundary of said Michels Survey 1142 $\frac{1}{10}$ varas a stake from which a Spanish Oak bears S. 11° E. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas, also a Double Spanish Oak bears N. 19° W. 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ varas. Thence
