KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Adam Lummalt having served faithfully and honorably for the term of three months from the sixth day of June 1836 until the sixth day of September 1836 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to three hundred & twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Adam Lummalt is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

Survey for Adam Zumwalt of 320 acres of Land situated on the waters of Peach Creek distant from Gonzales 10 miles it being the quantity of land to which he is entitled to by virtue of Land warrant No. <sup>1009</sup> dated at Houston <sup>1837</sup> Nov. 21<sup>st</sup> issued to said Zumwalt Beginning at a stake set for S E corner of a survey of 369 acres made for said Zumwalt from which a post oak 18 inches dia bears S 59° W 130 varas marked S and another 20 inches in dia marked H bears S 41° W 168 <sup>10</sup> varas

Thence with the north line of survey at 0 5 in chap at 0 10  
 S 79° E 290 varas to the S W corner of survey at 0 4 in chap at 10

Thence with west lines of said survey Number 4 and 1  
 N 1° E 2174 varas set a stake on the west line of survey at 0 1 in chap at 0 10 from which a post oak 14 inches in dia marked A bears N 1° W 150 varas and another 7 inches in dia marked B S 64° W 60 varas

Thence in true line

N 79° W 1450 varas set a stake on the E line of a survey of <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of a league and labor made for the heirs of Saml M'Boy from which a post oak 8 inches in dia marked C bears S 41° W 30 varas and another 9 inches in dia marked H bears S 31° E 110 varas

Thence with the E line of said survey

S 1° W 1014 varas to the S E corner of said survey from which a post oak 9 inches in dia marked M bears N 70° W 120 and another 8 inches in dia marked H bears N 52° E 100 varas

Thence with the N line of survey of 369 acres made for said <sup>walt</sup> Zumwalt  
 S 89° E 1260 to its <sup>N E</sup> corner a stake from which a post oak 9 inches in dia marked S bears S 22° W 1080 varas and another 11 inches in dia marked H <sup>N</sup> 36° W 190 varas

Thence with the E line of said Survey  
S.W. 11600 acres to the beginning February 25<sup>th</sup> 1839
