sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 80 acres of vacant public land, situated

in said county, and surveyed for George Allum on the 14th day of

August 1890, by J. J. Gillespie Deputy Surveyor of said county; that

he has occupied and improved the same as a homestead for the period of three consecutive years, beginning

on the 14th day of August 1890; that he is a single man and that he

makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a homestead, under "An Act for the

benefit of actual occupants of the public lands," approved May 26, 1873, and that he has not a homestead

other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Dudley D. S. Day

and Samuel Griffin, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known,

who being duly sworn, depose and say that George Allum the person first

above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a homestead the land surveyed

for him on the 14th day of August 1890, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the

period of three years, and they, nor either of them, have any interest in the said land.
