This is to certify that, the Heirs of Bradford Davis deceased are entitled to an unconditional certificate for six hundred and forty acres of land, by virtue of Conditional Certificate issued to Bradford Davis on 7th day of November A.D. 1839, No 241. Second Clasp. by the Board of Land Commissioners of Nacogdoches County for six hundred and forty acres of land.

They having made all the proof to the County Court of said Houston County, that is required under the provisions of an act entitled "An act to authorize the County Courts to issue unconditional Headright certificates where conditional certificates only have issued." Passed, February 4, 1854." and under the provisions of the above recited act, this unconditional Certificate is now issued.

In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and caused the Seal of the County Court of Houston County to be hereunto affixed at Crockett this 12th day of September A.D. 1854.
