authorized Surveyor, upon any of the vacant and unappropriated domains of the State of Texas within
the limits of said "Reserve," Eighty
Acres of Land to be surveyed in a square, should surveys made before the passage of the act in-
corporating the Mississippi and Pacific Railroad, (December 21st, 1855,) admit of it.

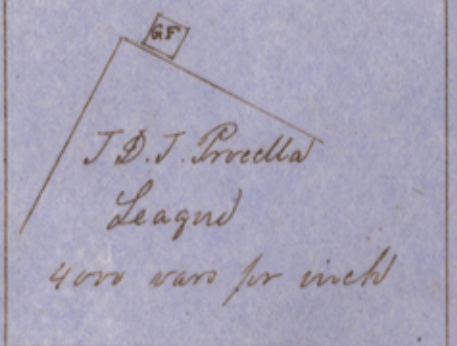
