THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that *Stephen Boy* has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Houston, and proved according to law that *he assumed in* this Republic

November 1834 and that *he* is a *Married Man* and entitled to *one labor and fifty cents* of land, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Three dollars* for each labor of Irrigable land. *two dollars and fifty cents* for each labor of temporal or arable land and *one dollar and twenty cents* for each labor of pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to *him* by this certificate.

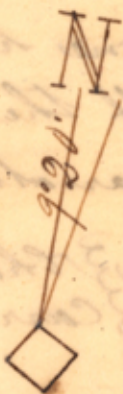
