KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

That Edward Fitzsimon having served faithfully and honorably for the term of 12 months from the 1st day of May 1836 until the 1st day of May 1837 and having been killed in the battle of Mier is entitled to 127 1/2 acres of Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said E. Fitzsimon or his heirs is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.
