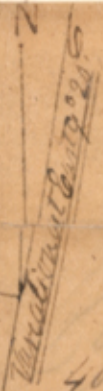

do nominate constitute and appoint W. J. Sadler Esq.
my true and lawfull attorney for me and in my
name and for my use to apply at the General
Land office and receive the patent due me for my
own private 640 acres of Land and in my
name receipt therefor if need be all tickets
in the premises shall be as binding on me as
if I had done and performed the same in person
waiving all forms of Law making this obligatory
on me according to its true intent and meaning
