That *Joseph D. Poyas* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Three* Months from the *10th* day of *December* 1836 until the *13th* day of *June* 1837 and having been honorably discharged from the Army is entitled to *Three hundred and twenty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Joseph D. Poyas* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

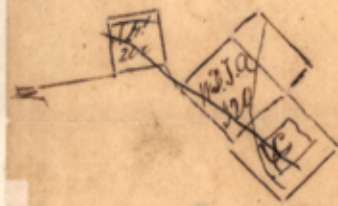

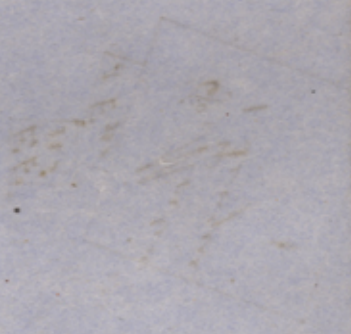
