well known who after being duly sworn  
deposeth and says that he is the legal and  
equitable owner of a Patent issued by Thomas  
M. Ward Commissioner of the Gen. Land office  
of Texas for 860 some odd acres of land  
<sup>apportioned</sup> his own head right which was located &  
patented upon an old survey known as  
the Moses Gregg League lying in Houston  
County Texas and that he has not sold or  
transferred said Patent but he sent it to  
Judge Randolph to have a bill presented to  
the Legislature for his relief said Randolph  
as affiant is informed and believes introduced  
a bill for that purpose but owing to a general  
bill of that character having been introduced  
said Randolph dropped his special bill  
& said Patent as affiant is informed still  
remains in the archives of the Legislature.

Affiant makes this affidavit for the purpose  
of showing he is the owner of said Patent and  
also for the purpose of having said Patent  
cancelled by the Commissioner of the General  
Land office as the whole of the land called  
for in said Patent is covered by the Grant  
of the Mexican Government to said Moses  
Gregg
