This is to Certify that Charles J. Broxton has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County aforesaid, and proved according to Law that he arrived in the Republic of Texas (now the State of Texas) in the year Eighteen hundred and forty one, that he ~~is~~^{was} a married man at that time, and having never received a Certificate for the quantity of Land for which he applies, is entitled to a unconditional grant of six hundred and forty acres of Land. He also having proved that he has resided in the same ever since, and performed all the duties required of him as a Citizen.

Given under our hands and the Seal of the County, this 11th day of October 1847.

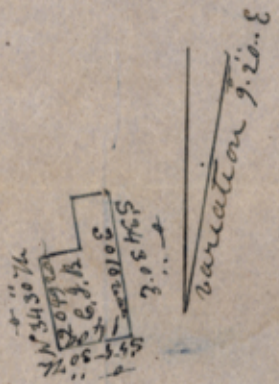
