And the said Wm Smith & Samuel M. Criss are entitled to hold said LAND, Alienate, Convey and Donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

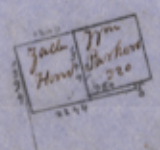

Craven, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Craven a certain Land Certificate and the land to be located by virtue thereof known and described as follows "No 1507 - for three hundred and twenty acres, issued at Austin, on 13th day of Sept A.D. 1850, by James C. Killett Adjutant General, to Daniel M. Crist assignee of Wm Smith, being the bounty land certificate of said Smith for services in the army of the Republic of Texas. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold said certificate and the land to be located as aforesaid unto the said Craven his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend said certificate & land to said Craven his heirs and assigns against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & Seal this 22 day of February A.D. 1854.
