Ellis of the aforesaid County, and State, Land Certificate or Script No. 17304 Issued February 7th 1843, by Stephen, Crosby, Commissioner of Public Land Office, to Crook Proprietor for 160 Acres of Land, together with all, and in full of the rights, Hereditaments, appertinances, and Titles to the same, belonging or in any wise incident have, and to hold for ever for his own use and purpose. And I further bind myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns firmly by these presents, to warrant, and forever defend unto the said James, B. Ellis, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, the above mentioned, and described, Land Certificate or Script against every, and all persons whomsoever, may lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof through or by me.
