Republic of Texas } In the District Court
County of Harrison } for said County Fall Term
A.D. 1844

Whereas Colin de Bland having filed his Petition under oath in the District Court for said County claiming of the Republic two thirds of a league and a labor of land as the residue or balance to which he is entitled, as a resident citizen of Texas, and the head of a family at the date of the Declaration of Independence and it further appearing by said Petition, that the said Colin de Bland did not leave the Country during the Campaign of the Spring of 1836. to avoid a participation in the struggle, that he did not aid or assist the enemy, that he did not refuse to participate in the war, that he with his family aforesaid, have been and remained citizens of this Republic ever since the Declaration of Independence; that he has never received a certificate for his quantum of land (and that he is fully entitled by reason of the premises, and under the Constitution and laws of the Republic to the said amount, of two thirds of a league and a labor of land, for which he has never received any grant or title, — And whereas the suit so instituted by Petition as aforesaid, in due course of law, came on for trial, at and before the District Court, for said County, at the Fall Term thereof 1844 — William C. Young District Attorney assisted by Bennett H. Martin an Attorney appointed by the Court, for that purpose mutually representing the interest of the Republic when and where a jury of good and lawful men being empannelled to try said cause and the testimony and arguments, adduced by the Parties being heard, the said cause was submitted to the said Jury. under the charge of the presiding Judge

Whereupon the said Jury having retired, found and returned into Court, their Verdict for and in favour of the Claimant, therein, and thereby awarding to him two thirds of a league and a labor of land


There are therefore to certify, that the said Colon de Bland is by reason of the Premises, entitled to, two thirds of a league and a labor of land, the same being a head right of the first Class, and the Claimant, not having received his Certificate for the same, from any of the boards of Land Commissioners heretofore in existence

Wherefore the Commissioners of the General Land Office, in accordance with the Rule prescribed in the eleventh section of the Statute, entitled, "An Act Supplementary to an Act, to detect fraudulent Land Certificates, and to provide for issuing Patents, to legal Claimants," Approved 4th day of February 1841, will issue the proper Certificate to the Claimant, aforesaid

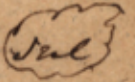
