REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.



IN CONFORMITY with an Act passed by the General Congress of the Republic of Texas,

approved on the 3d day of June, 1837, entitled "An Act for the relief of James Erwin and others," which act requires the Secretary of the Treasury to issue Land Scrip to individuals, in conformity with its provisions, therefore, I DO HEREBY CERTIFY that *the land scrip of J. Erwin* is entitled to SIX HUNDRED AND FORTY ACRES OF LAND, to be located at the expense of this Government, on any vacant and unappropriated lands within the Republic of Texas, according to the provisions of said act, and to have preference over all other claims originating after the first day of October eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

This Certificate is transferable by assignment, and lands acquired by virtue of a location made under its authority, may be held by Aliens upon the same terms as those held by citizens; and are not subject to forfeiture for non-cultivation non-improvement nor extra taxation over other lands of equal quality.
