The South boundary of Form. V. Morgan 446.60 acre survey with which this joins, according to its field notes only 2077 ws. in length & not 2206 ws. as is called for here. In consequence of this difference it comes in conflict with John Henry's fld. 320 acre survey, although it calls for its S.W. boundary line. Besides the distance from Form. V. Morgans S. E. Corner to John W. Henry's S. W. Corner should be $1344 - 928 = 416$ ws. instead of only 175 ws. as is called for here.
