Sullivan* has appeared before us, the **BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS** FOR THE COUNTY OF *Milam* and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country in *October* *Year 1835* and that he is a single man and entitled to *one third of a League* of **LAND**, upon the condition of paying at the rate of _____ for every labor of irrigable land, *Five dollars* for every labor of temporal or arable land, *Two dollars 75c* for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

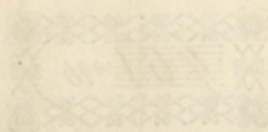

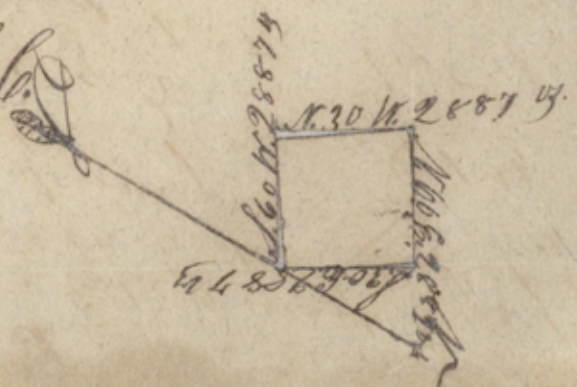


Survey for Augustine W. Sillavren of Eight
 Labors & $333.333\frac{1}{3}$ square veras of Land. Situated
 on the west side of the Brazos river & six miles
 west of the Town of Nashville. Being the quantity
 of Land to which he is entitled by virtue of a
 Certificate No 106 issued by the Board of Land
 Commissioners for the County of Milam. Beginning
 at the S.W. corner of a survey made for Mr. W. D.
 Bell assignee of David Farmer. A stake in the
 edge of prairie Thence S. 60 W. with the N. boundary
 line of League No 2. at 2660 yd pass the N.W.
 corner of 3d League at 2817 yd enter prairie at
 2887 yd come to the S.W. corner a stake in prairie
 Thence N. 30 W. through prairie at 1200 yd enter
 Black jack - at 2887 yd come to the N.W. corner
 a stake from which a Post oak 24 inches in dia-
 meter bears N 75 1/2 W. 15 yd marked S. & another Post
 oak 4 inches in diameter bears S. 25 1/2 W. 6 yd
 marked S. W. Thence N. 60 E. through Black jack
 & Post oak at 2887 yd comes to the N.E. corner a Black
 jack from which a Post oak 20 inches in diameter bears
 N. 71 W. 10 yd marked S. and a Black jack 15 inches
 in diameter bears N. 50 E. 12 yd marked S. W. Thence
 S. 30 E. through Black jack at 1050 yd pass the N.W.
 corner of Mr. W. Bell's survey Thence with the west
 boundary line of sd survey at 2887 yd comes
 to the place of beginning.

This survey contains to the best of my
 knowledge & belief Eight Labors & $333.333\frac{1}{3}$ square
 veras of Pasture Land.
