and proved according to law, that *he* arrived in the Country in *1835* December
and that *he* is a *Married* man and entitled to *one league* labor
of land upon condition of paying at the rate of *five Dollars*
for each labor of Irrigable land _____
for each labor of Temporal or arable land, *and two Dollars forty cents*
for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to *him*
by this Certificate.

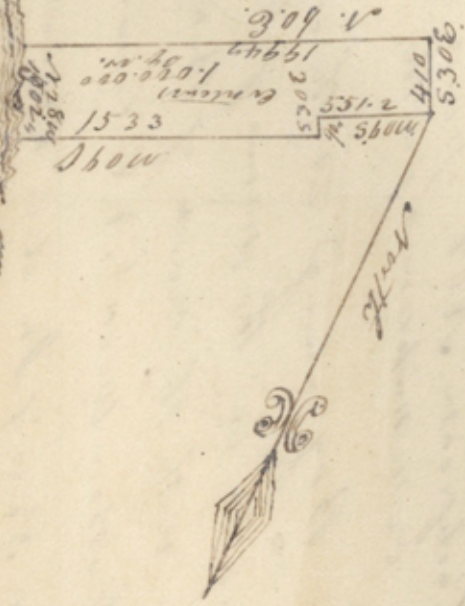

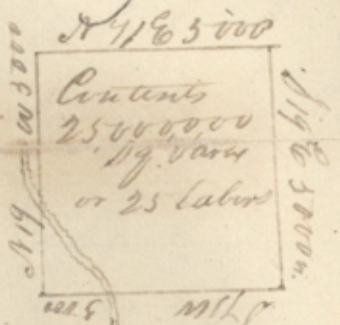


Survey for James Shaw of 25 labors of land situated on the 2nd Yegua, being a part of the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of a Certificate No. 2, issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Brazoria.

Beginning at the S.E. Corner of League No. 1, 1st Mos. Morrow Town. Thence S. 19° E. with the west line of S. Collins Third 1887 varas to the S.W. Corner of Sd Third - Continued 2387 m. to prairie - Continued 2887 varas to timber - Continued 5000 varas to a Stake (S.E. Corner) from which a Post oak 20 Inches in diameter, 4 varas bears N. 82° E. - also a Post oak 11 Inches in diameter 14 varas bears N. 30° E. - Thence S. 71° W. at 2 1/2 m. crossed the Spring Branch Continued 3886 varas crossed the 2nd Yegua bearing S. 19° E.
