No. 434 UNCONDITIONAL.

John McBrown has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Harris and proved according to law, that he arrived in this Republic prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> 1842 and that he has been a Resident Citizen up to the present time; that he is a <sup>single</sup> single man, and therefore entitled to ~~three hundred twenty acres~~ of Land, to be Entered and Surveyed from any Vacant Land of the Republic. *Conditional cert. in Galveston Co. No 101 May 2<sup>d</sup> 1839 for 320 acres*

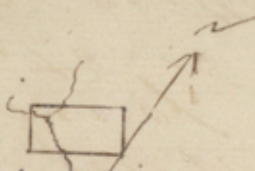


