army or navy and is entitled to the benefit of a homestead **of LAND,**

to be surveyed after the first day of August 1838.

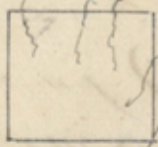

Harris Republic of Texas for and in consideration of
the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) to me in hand paid
by Henry Baker of said County and Republic
aforesaid have this day granted bargained & sold
unto the said Baker all my right title and interest
in and unto one third League of Land (unlocated)
as will more fully appear by reference to a certain
Certificate granted to me (William McFarland)
by the Land Commissioners of the County of Harris
(which Certificate is herunto annexed) which county
at the date of this Certificate was called Harrisburg
Said Certificate dated sixteenth June A.D. one thousand
eight hundred and thirty eight and signed by
J. Hutchinson President Thomas W. Warren
and A. J. Davis Clerk and John Woodhuff associate
Commissioners and attested by A. J. Davis Clerk
No 404 the said Baker to have and to hold the same
unto himself his heirs and assigns forever.
The said Baker is also hereby authorized and
empowered to call upon the Government of Texas
for a Patent for the same when located
and this conveyance will be his authority
for so doing. In witness whereof I have
herunto affixed my hand & seal (using my
scroll as a seal) this fourteenth day of February
one thousand eight hundred and forty five.
The erasure in line seventeenth was made before signing.
