This is to certify that William Hussung has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County aforesaid and proving according to law that he emigrated to this Country previous to the first day of October A.D. 1837 that he resided permanently in the Republic three years and more and performed all the duties required of him as a citizen that he is a single man and is entitled to an unconditional grant of six hundred and forty acres of land, in accordance with an act of Congress approved the tenth day of January A.D. 1843 in having proved to us that he has never at any other time or place procured a certificate for the land for which he now applies.

Given under our hands at the City of Galveston this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1845
